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【Fuji-Q Highland Rules for Visiting with Dogs】

※At the entrance, we will verify that you have brought water for rinsing away urine (in a water bottle) and waste bags. Please be sure to bring them.

※If you agree to the terms and conditions, please check the box below.

Terms and Agreements	Check Box
1. Only dogs with a shoulder height of 50 cm or less are permitted to enter the park and ride the Ferris wheel, Teacups, and the “Risa & Gaspard Carousel” .	☐
2. To enter the park, dogs must be vaccinated against rabies and have received a combination vaccine. Dogs with infectious diseases are not permitted. Please note that we reserve the right to refuse entry depending on your dog’s condition at the time of admission.	☐
3. Never let go of your dog’s leash inside the park. Always keep your dog on a leash held securely by an adult. Please use a commercially available leash no longer than 2 meters. Homemade leashes are not permitted. If using a retractable leash, it must be locked at a maximum length of 2 meters.	☐
4. Waste bags are required for entry. Owners must clean up after their dogs and take the waste home. If your dog urinates, please wash it away with water. Please bring a water bottle for this purpose; this will be checked at the entrance.	☐
5. Dogs are not permitted in shops, restaurants, restrooms, indoor facilities, or the Central Park lawn. You may pass through Shop Fujiyama only if your dog is in a pet cart or being carried; however, shopping with your dog is prohibited. Dogs are permitted in Thomas Land only if they are fully enclosed in a pet cart or a similar carrier. Before entering indoor facilities (shops, restaurants, restrooms), please brush any dog hair off your clothing and use hand sanitizer if available.	☐
6. When dining in the park with your dog, please use the terrace seating or purchase take-out food.	☐
7. Please be considerate of guests who are afraid of dogs or have pet allergies. Do not place dogs directly on benches or tables in the park, as these are public facilities.	☐
8. Please do not leave your dog unattended or with park staff or other guests, even for a short time, to avoid any potential incidents.	☐
9. Brushing your dog inside the park is prohibited.	☐
10. Ensure that your dog does not harm or disturb other guests. The park assumes no liability for any injuries, accidents, or disputes involving your dog. <u>If your dog damages park property, you will be held fully liable for the actual repair costs.</u>	☐
11. <u>Any disputes or accidents between dogs in the park must be resolved by the respective owners.</u> In the event of a “biting incident”, the owner must contact the public health center. Furthermore, the owner is solely responsible for providing medical care and compensation to the victim.	☐

Violation of these rules may result in expulsion from the park. No refunds will be issued for 1-day passes or ride tickets.
